As we have worked with ladies from prison, we have recognized their greatest desire is to be with their children. The transition period after incarceration is never an easy one. For many, their only option is to move back to the home from which they came. It is often a snare for them.

The Refuge is located in a very secluded area that will provide a place of security, solitude and a place to re-connect with their children.
